Numbers 21:1-9

II. Victory & Discouragements

1. Victory Over Enemies (vv. 1-3)

a. Instead of being fearful of the Canaanites like their fathers, the New Generation relied on the Lord to give them victory. (vv.1-2)

b. The Lord heard Israel’s plea and gave the Canaanites over to them (v.3)

c. Sihon and Og: Giants who were considered undefeatable due to their size and power. (vv. 21-35)
2. Discouragements on the Long Journey (v.4)

a. The Israelites went from Mount Hor along the route to the Red Sea, Around Edom.

b. Because of Challenges of the Journey (AMP Version)

III. Sin & Salvation

1. A New Generation but Same Old Sin

a. Gave into grumbling against God (v.5)

b. God sent venomous snakes and many died (v.6): Hebrews 12:6; Proverbs. 3:11-12
2. A Different Response: Willingness to Repent and Embrace Correction (v. 7)

a. Confession: We have sinned

b. Humility & Dependence: Pray for us
3. Salvation: Look at it and Live! (vv. 8-9)

a. The bronze serpent on a pole: God’s cure for sin

b. Look to Jesus (John 3:14-16)

c. Jesus became sin for us so that in him we might become the righteousness of God (2 Corinthians 5:21)
