Sermon

The Story of God: Do You See What I See?
1 Samuel 16:1-13

Speaker: Pastor Brian

- I. God Moves Samuel from Mourning to Mission

 - 3. Samuel Obeyed (v.4)

- II. Do You See What I See?
- 1. The Grand Story: What God is Doing and How God is Moving (1 Samuel 3:3; 13:14)
 - 2. What Do You See? (vv.6-7)
 - a. Samuel Saw the External Qualities (Outer Appearance)
 - b. The Lord Looks at the Internal Qualities (The Heart)
 - 3. This is the One: David (the youngest) Anointed as the Next King (vv.11-13)

- III. Application/Reflections
- 1. **Reflection:** What stood out from the sermon and why?
 - 2. **Mourning to Mission**
 - a. Where in your life might you still be “mourning” like Samuel—stuck in regret, disappointment, or sorrow? How have you seen sorrow turn into fear, isolation, or bitterness—either in your life or someone else’s?
 - b. Discuss a time when disappointment or the failure of others tempted you to step away from God or ministry.
 - c. How can we help one another move toward healing and mission?
 - 3. **The Story of God:** Where in your life do you need to take a step back and see the bigger picture of what God is doing?
 - 4. **Godly Values:** What are some ways we demonstrate that we value external qualities instead of the internal qualities in others?
