Speaker: Pastor Raymond Chang



Pastor Raymond Chang is the Executive for Advocacy and Strategic Initiatives at the TENx10 Collaboration out of Fuller Seminary. TENx10 is a collaborative movement geared towards making faith matter more for 10 million young people over 10 years in the spirit of John 10:10. Ray is also the president of the Asian American Christian Collaborative, a pastor, and a writer.

Prior to his role at Fuller, Raymond served as the Associate Chaplain for Discipleship at Wheaton College. He also worked in the for-profit and nonprofit sectors, and served in the Peace Corps in Panama.

Raymond is currently pursuing his PhD on the intersection of Spirituality and Campus/Organizational Racial Climates. Raymond has written chapters for many books and recently co-authored Future-Focused Church: Leading Through Change, Engaging the Next Generation, and Building a More Diverse Tomorrow.

He and his wife, Jessica Min Chang, are proud parents of Sophia, and they reside in Chicago.
