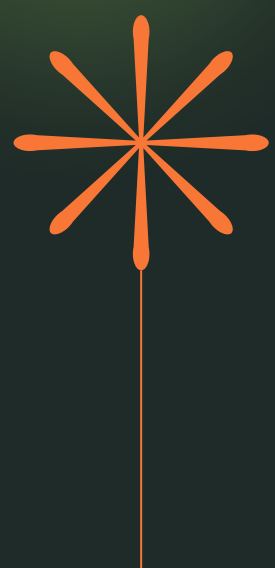

James was born in South Korea and is a citizen of both the U.S. and Canada. His call to ministry began in the summer of 1991 after a short-term mission trip to Haiti. In 1996, while reading Galatians 2:20 and experiencing a life-changing hospital stay, James fully surrendered to God's call to serve in missions full-time.

James has served with Pioneers, an international missions agency, in various leadership roles. He was the Vice President of Mobilization for Pioneers USA (2002-2011) and the President of Pioneers Canada (2012-2018). In 2019, he and his family returned to the U.S. to care for his ailing mother and his in-laws. Currently, he serves as the Regional Mobilizer for Pioneer USA. His passion is to inspire, develop, and empower courageous global leaders who are biblically grounded, culturally agile, and growing in character and intimacy with Jesus Christ. He accomplishes this through coaching and mentoring emerging leaders.

In addition to his ministry, James is pursuing a Ph.D. in Leadership at Lancaster Bible College. He is married to Lauren, who also serves with Pioneers as the Director of Strategic Initiatives for the Member Development Team. Together, they have three daughters: Chloe, a senior at the University of Maryland College Park; Zoe, a junior at New York University; and Phoebe, a high school senior.

James enjoys walking and hiking with his dog, Xander, gardening vegetables, caring for houseplants, and reading.
