## Sermon

**Human Flourishing: A Key to Missional Life**  
**Genesis 1:26-28**

Speaker: Pastor James Kim

### I. Introduction

1. How do you engage the Bible – piecemeal or in full context?
2. In what ways have you overlooked the significance of the beginning and end of the biblical narrative?

### II. Human Flourishing: Understanding the Missional Life

1. How does understanding human flourishing as God’s design (rather than just personal happiness or success) change the way you view your own life and purpose?
  - a. In what areas of your life do you see alignment with God’s vision for flourishing?
  - b. What might you need to refocus your priorities to better reflect His design?
2. Jesus came to restore what was lost in the Fall, bringing us back into the right relationship with God and others. In what ways can you participate in that restoration?
  - a. How can you bring shalom (peace, wholeness, well-being, etc.) into your family, workplace, or community?

### III. Blessed to Flourish: The Foundation for Missional Life

1. How does understanding that you are a redeemed and restored image-bearer of God impact the way you see yourself and your purpose?
  - a. In what areas of your life do you struggle to embrace this identity?
  - b. How can you live more intentionally as a reflection of God’s character in your daily interactions?
2. As God’s image-bearers, we are entrusted with stewarding His creation wisely. How are you stewarding the resources, opportunities, and relationships God has given you?
  - a. Are there areas where you could be more faithful in caring for what God has placed under your responsibility?
  - b. What specific changes can you make to align your life more fully with God’s mission of flourishing?

### IV. Cultivating Flourishing: Our Missional Calling

1. How does viewing the gospel as more than just personal salvation change your understanding of your role in God’s mission?
  - a. Have you ever thought of yourself as being on the “sidelines” of Christianity? If so, what has held you back from fully engaging in God’s mission?
  - b. In what ways can you step onto the “playing field” and actively participate in God’s work of restoration and flourishing?
2. God saw more in the Israelites than just their past as enslaved people – He saw a people chosen for His purposes. What do you think God sees in you?
  - a. Do you view yourself primarily through your past failures or through the identity God has given you?
  - b. How can you begin to live with the confidence that you are God’s “treasured possession” and an active participant in His mission?
3. God calls His people to be a “royal priesthood” (1 Peter 2:9). How can you live out this identity in your daily life?
  - a. How can you reflect God’s character and goodness in your family, workplace, neighborhood, or social circles?
  - b. What practical steps can you take to cultivate a space – like Myra’s pancake nights – where people feel welcomed, valued, and drawn to God’s light?
