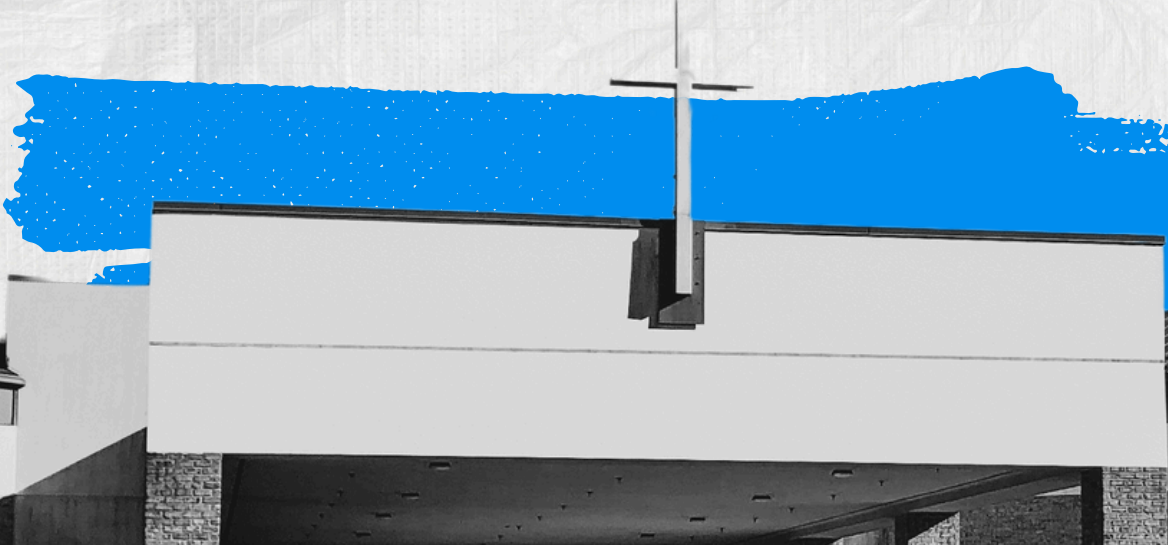

A Psalm for Giving Thanks

Psalm 100:1-5 (ESV)

Introducing Africa Continent Mission (ACM)

ACM was founded in 1985 by missionaries Chong Yang and Sang Won Kim. They began the mission work in Malawi with a vision to plant local Churches in the remotest parts of Africa. By the grace of God, they have currently planted over 680 churches in 7 nations. ACM strives to make disciples of Jesus Christ throughout the continent of Africa through local communities that moves in the power of the Holy Spirit.

The joy of planting Churches also led ACM to build several schools ranging from orphanages to high schools where thousands of students receive the gospel centered education. Many of the ACM leaders are trained at Immanuel Bible College in South Africa. In South Africa, we help the local community through the Macadamia nuts farm project and running a Korean style prayer mountain where people can pray on the beautiful mountains of South Africa.

Ten years ago, ACM started the very first Medical School in Eswatini (EMCU) where 1,000 students are currently enrolled in the nursing, radiology, psychology, and much more. This year marks the first enrollment of 8 medical students who are making their journey to be the first locally trained medical doctors. You can read more about it at www.emcu.ac.sz

This year, ACM will begin a second University in Mozambique where we also have a banana farm to support this endeavor. The project is currently funded by a local businessman, but we continue to seek partnership in the United States and Korea.
