3. If we don't build for God, we are building in vain. Philipians 4:19

#### II. "Otherwise"

1. "Otherwise we will be scattered over the face of the whole earth" Genesis 11:4
2. "Otherwise" is the fear that causes our rebellion towards God and his plans.
3. 2 Timothy 1:7 "For God has not given us a spirit of fear"

#### III. God Plans Can't Be Stopped

1. What humanity plans is not impossible for them. Genesis 11:6
2. Confusion is a blessing
3. God's plans start to work when the fear of the "Otherwise" is taken away

James has served with Pioneers, an international missions agency, in various leadership roles. He was the Vice President of Mobilization for Pioneers USA (2002-2011) and the President of Pioneers Canada (2012-2018). In 2019, he and his family returned to the U.S. to care for his ailing mother and his in-laws. Currently, he serves as the Regional Mobilizer for Pioneer USA. His passion is to inspire, develop, and empower courageous global leaders who are biblically grounded, culturally agile, and growing in character and intimacy with Jesus Christ. He accomplishes this through coaching and mentoring emerging leaders.

In addition to his ministry, James is pursuing a Ph.D. in Leadership at Lancaster Bible College. He is married to Lauren, who also serves with Pioneers as the Director of Strategic Initiatives for the Member Development Team. Together, they have three daughters: Chloe, a senior at the University of Maryland College Park; Zoe, a junior at New York University; and Phoebe, a high school senior.
