I. Let's Make a Name For Ourselves:

- 1. All spoke the same language, had the same goal. Genesis 11:1-4
- 2. What does the Tower of Babel represent?
- 3. If we don't build for God, we are building in vain. Philippians 4:19

II. "Otherwise"

- 1. "Otherwise we will be scattered over the face of the whole earth" Genesis 11:4
- 2. "Otherwise" is the fear that causes our rebellion towards God and his plans.
- 3. 2 Timothy 1:7 "For God has not given us a spirit of fear"

III. God Plans Can't Be Stopped

- 1. What humanity plans is not impossible for them. Genesis 11:6
- 2. Confusion is a blessing
- 3. God's plans start to work when the fear of the "Otherwise" is taken away
