The Calling: From Conviction to Action
Nehemiah 1-2

- IV. Application
- 1. Nehemiah's calling began with a burden for God's people rather than a desire for a position or title. What situations, people, or needs consistently stir your heart? How might God be using that burden to invite you into His work?
 - 2. Nehemiah responded by weeping, fasting, praying, confessing, and seeking God's direction before taking action. Which part of Nehemiah's response is most challenging for you? Why?
 - 3. Is there a recent conviction from Scripture or a sermon that you've ignored or delayed acting on? What is one practical step of obedience you can take this week?
 - 4. Nehemiah faced fear, uncertainty, and opposition, yet he persevered because he trusted God's leading. What fears, distractions, or challenges are making it difficult for you to obey God?
