4. What does it mean for you personally to "come and see" and then believe? What step of faith might God be inviting you to take?
5. The tomb became a place of transformation—from death to hope. How has God brought life or hope out of a "dead" or hopeless situation in your life?
6. How does the resurrection renew your understanding of faith, hope, and love in your daily life?
