Sermon

Rebuilding the Temple and Our Hearts
Ezra 7-11

Speaker: Pastor David

- I. Ezra’s main purpose was not just the physical restoration of the temple but the spiritual restoration of the people (7:25)
- II. The original group of returning Israelites were filled with hope of restoring Jerusalem to its former glory
 1. Willing to sacrifice (2:68)
 2. Dedicated to worship (3:3)
 3. Obedient to God (4:1-3)
- III. But when Ezra came and saw their sin, he had to remind the people of their purpose
 1. Together As One (3:1)
 2. Began to Build the Altar (3:2) What is the significance of this?
 3. Forgiveness through Sacrifice (Isaiah 43:22-25)
 4. Relationship Restored (Isaiah 43:21)
 5. Different Responses to God’s Invitation
- IV. Full restoration requires:
 1. Build something – be active
 2. Sacrifice – give offerings
 3. Repentance – take sin seriously
- V. Reflection Questions
 1. "Why are we following Jesus?" How would you answer that question honestly today?
 2. Ezra was deeply grieved by sin. How do you typically respond when you become aware of sin in your own life?
 3. Can you think of a time when your sin affected other people, not just yourself?
 4. How can Christians remain distinct from culture without withdrawing from people?
 5. Spiritual drift can often happen gradually, not suddenly. What are some warning signs that someone is drifting from God, and how can Christian community help us recognize and address those signs before they become major problems?
