The Lord Will Do Wonders
Joshua 3

- Joshua 1
- God prepares and encourages Joshua as the new leader of His people
- 1. Mantle of leadership passes from Moses to Joshua
 - 2. “Be strong and courageous”

Joshua 3

People of God	The Lord
Intentional waiting and consecration (v.2, 5)	God’s intentional use of waiting for good
Follow the presence of God (Ark of the Covenant) (v.3)	God is omnipresent and it is God who leads the way (v.6, 11)
–Go to the river’s edge and step in/cross over (v.14–15, 17) –Faith and Action go hand in hand (James 2:14–17)	–God clears the water and provides dry land to cross (v.16) “The Lord will do wonders among you” (Joshua 3:5)

III. Application

- 1. Where/how is God calling you to intentionally wait/pause?
- 2. Reflect on how and where God has called you to follow Him.
 - a. How willing are you to obey that calling and trust in His promises?
 - b. Where is God calling you to put your faith into action?
- 3. Have you lost your awe and wonder of God? What is getting in the way of holding God in awe?
 - a. How can we recapture the awe and wonder of God in our lives?
 - b. Read Psalm 145 this week as a place to start.
